UNchain Winston

It is illegal in Forsyth County to chain or tether a dog. Dogs must be spayed/neutered and current on rabies vaccination. See below for information on low-cost options.

Cold Weather Tips for Outdoor Pets

Consejos climáticos fríos para mascotas al aire libre



During the winter months, your pets need special attention to make sure they stay healthy. If possible, please bring dogs and cats inside to avoid frostbite or injury. While they are outside, please follow these suggestions:

Durante los meses de invierno, sus mascotas necesitan una atención especial para asegurarse de que estén sanas. Si es posible, por favor traiga perros y gatos adentro para evitar la congelación o lesiones. Mientras están afuera, por favor sigan estas sugerencias:

- **Increase the amount of food you give animals in the winter. They use more energy to stay warm during this time.**

Aumenta la cantidad de comida que le das a los animales en el invierno. Usan más energía para mantenerse calientes durante este tiempo.

- **Check water often to be sure it is not frozen, and change water every day so it remains fresh.**

Compruebe el agua a menudo para asegurarse de que no está congelada, y cambie el agua todos los días para que permanezca limpia.

- **Place a thick layer of cedar or pine shavings on the floor of the doghouse to help your pet stay warm. Avoid using blankets as they are likely to get wet and will freeze. Turn doghouse door away from the wind.**

Colocar una gruesa capa de cedro o virutas de pino en el piso de la casa de perro para que su mascota se mantenga caliente. Evite usar mantas ya que es probable que se mojen y se congelen. Gire la puerta de la casa de perro lejos del viento.

- **Warm car engines attract cats and wildlife. Bang on your car hood before starting the engine.**

Cálidos motores de autos atraen a gatos y a la vida salvaje. Golpee el capó de su coche antes de arrancar el motor.

- **Be sure to clean up antifreeze if it is spilled. This sweet-smelling liquid could be deadly to your animals if they lick it.**

Asegúrese de limpiar el anticongelante si se derrama. Este líquido de olor dulce podría ser mortal para tus animales si los lamen.
