



Warm Weather Tips for Pets Consejos para el clima cálido para mascotas



During the warm summer months, your pets need special attention to make sure they stay healthy. If possible, please bring dogs and cats inside to avoid heat exhaustion or heat stroke. While they are outside, please follow these suggestions:

Durante los meses cálidos de verano, sus mascotas necesitan atención especial para asegurarse de que se mantengan saludables. Si es posible, por favor traiga perros y gatos dentro para evitar el agotamiento por calor o la insolación. Mientras están fuera, por favor siga estas sugerencias:

- Always have fresh drinking water available for your pets.

Siempre tenga agua potable fresca disponible para sus mascotas.

- **NEVER** leave your pets unattended in a car – even with the windows cracked! Temperatures inside a parked car can reach temperatures over 100 degrees and pets can die in minutes.

***NUNCA** deje a sus mascotas desatendidas en un coche - incluso con las ventanas agrietadas! Las temperaturas dentro de un coche estacionado pueden alcanzar temperaturas superiores a los 100 grados y pueden volverse fatales en pocos minutos.*

- Provide shade and a dog house for your dog to get some relief from the direct sun.

Proporcione sombra y una casa para perros para que su perro obtenga un poco de alivio del sol directo.

- Watch for signs of overheating or heat stroke:

Call a veterinarian as soon as possible if they have any of the above symptoms. If your pet loses consciousness or is severely ill (vomiting, seizures, etc.) get to a vet hospital immediately!

Llame a un veterinario lo antes posible si presenta alguno de los síntomas anteriores. Si su mascota pierde el conocimiento o está gravemente enferma (vómitos, convulsiones, etc.), ¡acuda a un hospital veterinario de inmediato!

- If your pet gets too hot, take them to a cooler area and put a cool towel around their head, paws, and body.

Si su mascota se calienta demasiado, llévala a un área más fría y pon una toalla fría alrededor de su cabeza, patas y cuerpo.

- Keep your pet free of parasites that are more common during warm weather, such as fleas, ticks, and heartworm.

Mantenga a su mascota libre de parásitos que son más comunes durante el clima cálido, como pulgas, garrapatas y gusanos del corazón.
